

# MADE ON THE FARM

Children will find out all about the farm and where some natural products come from thanks to this original puzzle.



## COMPETENCES

- Get to know the farm animals

## HOW TO PLAY

Piecing together the puzzle, children will learn to observe a colourful image containing typical farm elements and will encounter lots of animals. In addition by sliding the 8 tabs, they will discover where we get certain products such as honey, milk, wine, eggs, wool and jam from.

Accompany your child's activities by naming the objects that are illustrated. Then explain and describe where the products on the tabs come from.

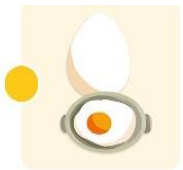
### Apple-Jam

There are lots of fruit trees on the farm such as apple, cherry and peach trees. We can make jams from the fruit they produce.

### Grapes-Wine

The fruits from the vines are called grapes, which can be different varieties. We make wine from grapes.





### Hen-Egg

Hens lay eggs, they can even lay one a day.



### Cow-Milk

The farmer milks the cows, and this milk can also be used to make cheese.

### Sheep-Wool

The farmer shears the sheep, to get wonderfully soft wool from its fleece.



### Bees-Honey

The bees live in the beehive and they collect nectar from flowers. They make honey from it.

### Olive-Oil

We get olives from olive trees, and turn them into olive oil to use for cooking.

### Corn-Pop Corn

Corn on the cob can also be turned into pop corn.
